
Documents required by CCOPMM for: Maternal death

Please provide the following documents (if applicable and available) within 28 days of death or as specified by CCOPMM:

- Internal health service review of death*
- Comprehensive obstetric and medical summary (including any previous pregnancies and outcomes, known pregnancy related disease, complications of birth and neonatal outcome)
- Surgical report
- Anaesthetic report
- Emergency department care report
- Critical care/Intensive care unit report discharge summary (including principal diagnosis, APACHE III diagnostic code, intubated/mode of ventilation, number of ventilated hours, ECMO, vital status on discharge from ICU (mortality))
- Referral letters and medical correspondence
- Post mortem examination*
- Placenta, cord and membrane histopathology
- Relevant imaging results (CT, MRI, x-ray, ultrasound)
- Relevant laboratory investigations (FBE, biochemistry, coagulation screens, viral serology, microbiology, genetic, metabolic)
- Ambulance transfer notes by paramedics or MICA
