


# **Safer Care Victoria Clinical Governance Maturity Matrix**

This factsheet provides key information about the Clinical Governance Maturity Matrix (CGMM)

## What is clinical governance?

The Victorian Clinical Governance Framework (VCGF) defines clinical governance as the integrated systems, practices and culture that are underpinned by a cycle of continuous planning, monitoring, learning and improvement, all in the pursuit of high-quality care delivery.

The VCGF identifies five interrelated domains required to deliver high-quality care: Leadership and culture, Partnering with consumers, Workforce, Risk management and Clinical practice.



## What is a maturity matrix?

- An assessment tool used to identify progress towards a goal or best practice
- Identifies domains, criteria and levels or indicators of maturity
- Supports identification of areas that require focused improvement
- Enables monitoring of maturity over time.

#### What is the CGMM?

An organisational self-assessment tool to measure clinical governance maturity, building on the VCGF, designed specifically for use within individual health service organisations.

The CGMM includes a toolkit of resources including guides, slideshow templates, and automated data reports to support your clinical governance self-assessment.

## Why assess clinical governance maturity?

The CGMM supports reflection, celebrates progress and guides improvement planning. Understanding organisational clinical governance maturity enables health services to:

- Identify clinical governance strengths and gaps
- Identify and prioritise clinical governance improvement areas
- Encourage honest reflection and shared learning across teams, without focusing on scores or comparisons
- Support continuous improvement by developing and implementing plans and monitoring clinical governance maturity over time.

### Who contributes to the CGMM process?

The CGMM has been designed for individual health services to strengthen clinical governance by:

- Engaging staff across all departments to build a shared understanding of local clinical governance
- Sharing findings and plans with health service consumers, Boards, staff, and governing bodies to support continuous improvement.
