MAGIC discharge checklist

Component	Tasks
M Medications	☐ Review medication guide and ensure appropriate preventer and reliever prescribed ☐ Dispense the appropriate medication prior to discharge where appropriate
A Asthma action plan	☐ Provide asthma action plan to child/young person and/or caregiver ☐ Provide teach-back education to assess understanding and address gaps ☐ Ask caregiver to take a photo of asthma action plan on their phone ☐ Upload asthma action plan to My Health Record
G GP integration	☐ Assist caregiver to book follow-up GP appointment for within 7 days of discharge ☐ Provide discharge summary/letter with recommended preventer/reliever to family ☐ Send discharge summary/letter with recommended preventer/reliever to GP
I Inhaler and spacer technique	☐ Provide teach-back education to child/young person and/or caregiver ☐ Confirm child/young person demonstrates appropriate inhaler and spacer technique ☐ Provide links to educational videos < https://www.rch.org.au/kidsinfo/fact_sheets/asthma-videos/ > for viewing after discharge
C Community asthma program	☐ Refer to community asthma program, where appropriate ☐ Provide information to child/young person and/or caregiver about referral and what to expect

Component	Tasks
Asthma diagnosis	For preschool children (1–5 years old) who have presented with 2 or more episodes of asthma symptoms (wheeze) which respond to asthma therapy (salbutamol/Ventolin): ☐ use the term 'preschool asthma' ☐ refer family to educational video < https://www.rch.org.au/kidsinfo/fact_sheets/asthma-videos/ >
Consumer satisfaction	☐ Ask child/young person and/or caregiver what matters to them ☐ Provide link to provide feedback to child/young person and/or caregiver
